## Summer School 2017!

ISD's **Summer Success** (for students 9-12) will be offered **May 30th - June 29th** Monday - Friday, from 8:30 am - 2:00 pm. William Chrisman High School will house **Summer Success** with a few courses offered at Truman and Van Horn High Schools. Two sessions will be offered. Session 1 times are 8:30 am - 11:15 am, with a 10 minute break and Session 2 times are 11:25 am - 2:00 pm. A shuttle will be provided between locations.

Breakfast and lunch will be available at no additional cost. Students will be able to make a la carte purchases using their meal accounts or cash.

## Enrollment

Enrollment is on-line. Simply go to [www.isdschools.org](http://www.isdschools.org) and click on the **Summer School** tab. Online enrollment will be open **March 13 - May 11**. (Waiting lists for enrollment will be created after May 11th.)

Students from any school, private or public, may attend and a paper registration is available by contacting the Summer Success Office 521-5508. Note: Some classes are only for ISD students and are noted in the course offerings section.

All students must be enrolled prior to the first day of summer school. No walk-ins on the first day.

## Getting There

Transportation for **Summer Success** will be provided for those students who qualify and register for transportation services by **May 11th**. You can register for transportation as a part of the on-line enrollment process at [www.isdschools.org](http://www.isdschools.org) and click on the **Summer School** tab.

The majority of summer school takes place at William Chrisman High School. Buses will only run before session 1 and after session 2. Bus passes will be mailed after the May 11th deadline. Credit Recovery and a few other courses will be at Truman and Van Horn. Buses will shuttle them to and from those locations.

Incoming freshmen - seniors will find the following course offerings available for our 2017 summer session. Students are allowed to take one class per session (with the exception of full credit courses) and can make up the equivalent of 1 credit. **Grade levels are reflective of student grade level for fall 2017.**
