Summer School 2018

ISD's **Summer Success** (for students entering 9-12) will be offered Monday - Friday from **May 29th - June 28th** at William Chrisman High School. A few **Summer Success** courses will also be offered at Truman and Van Horn High Schools. Each day is divided into two sessions.

Session 1: 8:30 a.m. - 11:15 a.m.

Session 2: 11:25 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

Transportation will be provided between locations. Breakfast and lunch will also be provided at no additional cost. Students will be able to purchase a la carte options using their meal accounts or cash.

Enrollment

Online enrollment will be open **March 20th - May 10th**. Visit www.isdschools.org and click on the **Summer School** tab located in the main menu. (Waiting lists for enrollment will be created after May 10th.)

Students from any school, private or public, may attend **Summer Success** in the Independence School District. Paper registration is available by contacting the Summer Success Office at 521-5508. Classes specifically offered for ISD students are indicated in the course offerings section.

All students must be enrolled prior to the first day of summer school. No walk-ins on the first day.

Getting There

Transportation for **Summer Success** will be provided for those students who qualify and register for transportation services by **May 10th**. You can register for transportation as a part of the on-line enrollment process at www.isdschools.org under the **Summer School** tab.

Bus passes for summer school will be mailed after the May 10th deadline. A few courses may be held at Truman and Van Horn. Shuttle buses will be provided.
