Summer School

ISD's **Summer Success** (for students entering 9-12) will be offered Monday - Friday from **July 1 - July 31 (no school only July 3)** at Truman High School. A few **Summer Success** courses will also be offered at Van Horn and William Chrisman High Schools. Each day is divided into two sessions.

***Session 1:** 8:30 a.m. - 11:15 a.m.

***Session 2:** 11:25 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

Transportation will be provided between locations. Breakfast and lunch will also be provided at no additional cost. Students will be able to purchase a la carte options using their meal accounts or cash.

Enrollment

Online enrollment will be open **May 4 - May 15**. Visit www.isdschools.org and click on the **Summer School** tab located in the main menu. (Waiting lists for enrollment will be created after **May 15**. Walk-ins will not be accepted.)

Students from any school, private or public, may attend **Summer Success** in the Independence School District. Paper registration is available by contacting the Summer Success office at 521-5508. Classes specifically offered for ISD students are indicated in the course offerings section.

Transportation

Transportation for Summer Success will be provided for those students who qualify and register for transportation services by **May 15**. You can register for transportation as a part of the online enrollment process at www.isdschools.org under the **Summer School** tab. If you qualify for transportation, you will receive your child's bus pass prior to the start of summer school.

A few courses may be held at Van Horn and William Chrisman. Shuttle buses will be provided.
