Students who need credit recovery and additional support in core content areas will receive an invitation to register for Summer Success between **March 8th - 19th**. Registration will open to all ISD students with limited availability between **March 22nd - April 9th** at www.isdschools.org. Kindergarten

We welcome students entering kindergarten for the 2021-2022 school year to enroll in Summer Success. You will first register your incoming kindergarten student for the 2021-2022 school year. At the completion of your registration for the upcoming school year, you will have the option to also register for Summer Success. 7th & 8th Grade

Summer Success for students entering seventh and eighth grade will focus on core content areas and credit recovery. Students who wish to add an elective to their schedule for the 2021-2022 school year may complete PE / Health for credit during Summer Success. This allows most students to choose two elective course options for their schedule in the upcoming school year.

Early Education
