Summer School

ISD's **Summer Success** (for students entering 9-12) will be offered **Monday - Thursday between June 1st - June 30th** at Truman High School. **Friday, June 3rd will be a Summer Success attendance day.** A few **Summer Success** courses will also be offered at Van Horn High School, William Chrisman High School and Nowlin Middle School. Transportation between locations will be provided. Breakfast and lunch will also be provided at no additional cost. Each day is divided into two sessions:

***Session 1:** 7:15 a.m. - 10:20 a.m.

***Session 2:** 10:30 a.m. - 1:55 p.m.

Online registration will be open **March 17th - May 6th.** Visit www.isdschools.org and click on the **Summer School** tab located in the main menu. Waiting lists for enrollment will be created after **May 6th.** Walk-ins will not be accepted.

Transportation

Transportation for Summer Success will be provided for those students who qualify and register for transportation services by **May 6th.**

Bus transportation will run prior to the 7:15 a.m. start and after the 1:55 p.m. dismissal. Buses will not transport students to/from home between sessions. If you qualify for transportation, you will receive your child's bus pass prior to the start of summer school.
