Semester 1:

Unit 1: Introduction to Fundamentals of Perform, Create, Connect, Respond

- Students will be introduced/review rhythms
- Students will be introduced fundamentals of singing
- Students will be introduced/review melodic reading
- Students will be introduced to listening and evaluation skills

Unit 2: Connect and Respond-Listening and Evaluation

- Students will be able to identify, articulate, and discuss a variety of the elements of music
- Students will be able to write and/or draw descriptions of their interpretations of the music
- Students will begin being able to identity the purpose of the music

Unit 3: Perform and Create- Composition and Performance

- Students will be able to perform on various instruments a variety songs together for as an ensemble and for an audience

- Students will study scenes to stage performing arts including comparing/contrasting the various styles
- Students will be able to understand plot inspiration throughout history (including: fable, myth, legends, story, and religious)

Unit 5: Connect and Respond-College Career Readiness

- Students will examine a variety of careers within the music industry.
- Students will determine which careers need higher education or on the job experience as well as estimated salaries in various regions of the United States
- Students will examine and research a stated number of careers of their choosing to present.
