Semester Class

Establishing a Positive Performance Space

- Develop and practice exercises in relaxation, focus, trust, and playfulness
- Develop and practice the art of being a positive audience member
- Develop and practice the art of tactful criticism

Audition Workshop

- Review types of auditions
- Identify and practice the process of preparing an audition

Develop Characterization Techniques
