Semester Class

Theatre Communication and Teamwork

- Understand effective communication practices in Theatrical Spaces.

Foundations of Set/Costume/Lights/Sound/Prop Design

- Analyze best practices for each design element.
- Document process of production and design throughout each design element.

Design Team in Practice

- Plan, as a team, a full scale production from the design team's perspective.
- Synthesize individual design elements into a coherent vision for unrealized production.
- Present renderings/model of design elements for an unrealized production.

Reflection

- Critique designs of various productions, both professional and personal.
- Respond to peers' design choices.
- Reflect upon personal design choices and set goals for future designs.
