Registration will open to all ISD students between March 7th - April 20th at www.isdschools.org. Students enrolled by April 20th will be guaranteed a spot in the Summer Success program. Wait lists for enrollment will be created after April 20th. **Walk-ins will not be accepted**. Additional information will be shared through ISD robocalls, emails and the District website.

Kindergarten

We welcome students entering kindergarten for the 2023-2024 school year to enroll in Summer Success. You will first register your incoming kindergarten student for the 2023-2024 school year. At the completion of your registration for the upcoming school year, you will have the option to also register for Summer Success. 7th & 8th Grade

Students who wish to add an elective to their schedule for the 2023-2024 school year may complete PE / Health for credit during Summer Success. This allows most students to choose two elective course options for their schedule in the upcoming school year. Summer school is condensed into one month. Any day missed is equivalent to missing three regular school days. Students taking P.E. and Health for credit during Summer Success may not exceed two absences.

Early Education

Children ages six weeks to four years may enroll in Early Education services. During the month of June, Early Education will be held at Hanthorn and combined sites.
