#### **Kindergarten - 5th Grade Clubs**

Club Options: Running/Walking Club, Reading Club, Arts & Crafts Club, Board Game Club, Team Sports Club.

Kindergarten - 5th Grade Clubs are *free*, extracurricular, teacherled offerings. There is no cost to families. The times and locations of these programs will vary, and that information will be provided at the start of each semester.

There may be additional club offerings at each combined site dependent upon its individual staff and student interests and needs, as well as available space and resources.

There is no district-provided transportation for these activities.

Note: signing your student up for one of these clubs means care is offered only for the duration of the club. **If full-day childcare is needed**, you must enroll and pay for Kids' Safari full-day childcare for that day. See the Kids' Safari section on page 8 for information.

#### Kindergarten - 5th Grade Learning League

8:30AM - 2:30PM | INVITE ONLY KINDERGARTEN STARTS OCT. 30

Learning League is a *free, invite-only*, instructional, guided tutoring program intended to help students improve academic performance. Learning League is for students who have been identified as being at least one grade level behind academically.

If your student is invited to participate, you will receive information from the district near the beginning of the school year.

The district will provide transportation services for Learning League.

Please note, Kindergarten Learning League starts October 30, 2023. Also, Learning League (all grades) is **not in session** September 18, 2023, January 22, 2024, and May 13, 2024.

Note: your student's participation in Learning League means care is offered only for the duration of the program. **If full-day childcare is needed**, you must enroll and pay for Kids' Safari full-day care for that day. See the Kids' Safari section on page 8 for information.

#### 6th - 12th Grade Clubs

8:30 - 10:15AM, 10:20AM - 12:25PM (INCLUDES LUNCH), 12:30 - 2:15PM NO SIGN UP REQUIRED

Information about these clubs will be made available at ISDschools.org/enrichment-opportunities as they are planned and formed throughout the school year. Offerings per school site will vary depending upon individual staff and student interests and needs, as well as available space and resources.

There is no district-provided transportation for these activities.

Note: your 6th-8th grade student's participation in one of these clubs means care is offered only for the duration of the club.

Academic Support Programming offered at our secondary level includes: **credit recovery, attendance recovery, and tutoring**. These are *free*, fifth-day offerings for students who choose to participate on non-instructional Mondays.

## K-8 Enrichment Programming For LS, FS, & CBSS Students

8:30 - 11AM OR 11:30AM - 2PM | INVITE ONLY

Enrichment Programming for Life Skills, Functional Skills and Communication Behavior Social Skills students will take place at Little Blue Elementary School (K-5) and Bingham Middle School (6-8). This programming will be alternative, non-instructional activities. IEP accommodations/modifications will be considered and/or provided.

There is no district-provided transportation for these activities.

## **Kids' Safari**

Kids' Safari is the ISD childcare program that offers fullday care on non-instructional Mondays in the ISD for Kindergarten - 8th grade.

Kids' Safari is offered at the same open combined sites where Enrichment Programming takes place on non-instructional Mondays. Kids' Safari also offers care beyond non-instructional Mondays, like Before and After School care and Full-Day care on the two non-instructional days Tuesday, November 7 and Tuesday, January 2.

## ISD + MCC Partnership

ISD high school students in 10th – 12th grade may take **college courses at MCC**, earning up to 24 college credit hours on Mondays.

These courses are in-person or hybrid (combined in-person and online) at MCC-Blue River in Independence. Tuition is deeply discounted to \$181.50 per course, plus there is financial assistance available to help through the ISD Foundation. Visit **OurISDF.org/scholarships** for information.
