Summer School

ISD's Summer Success (for students entering 9-12) will be offered **Tuesday - Friday between May 29th - June 28th** at William Chrisman High School. A few courses will also be offered at Truman High School, Van Horn High School, and Nowlin Middle School. Transportation between locations will be provided. Breakfast and lunch will be provided at no cost. Each day is divided into two sessions:

*Session 1: 7:15 a.m. - 10:20 a.m.

*Session 2: 10:30 a.m. - 1:55 p.m.

Please note: Class is in session on Monday 6/17 and there is NO school on Wednesday 6/19.

Transportation

Transportation for Summer Success will be provided for those students who qualify and register for transportation services by **May 7th**.

Bus transportation will run prior to the 7:15 a.m. start and after the 1:55 p.m. dismissal. Buses will not transport students to/from home between sessions. If you qualify for transportation, you will receive your child's bus pass prior to the start of summer school.
